May God Bless You and your families always

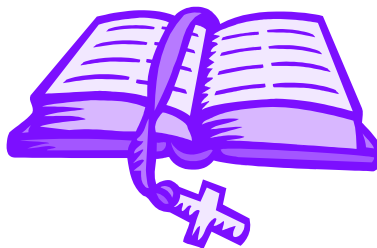
